Transracial Adoption: A Personal Reflection. Drawing on my own powerful transracial adoption experience I'm excited and honoured to deliver this seminar for Black History Month and to celebrate National Adoption Week. I shed light on the complexities and intricate bonds that make up transracial adoption, will open up lively conversations, examine best practice and explore new revelations on the concept of overseas adoption, DNA bonds and identity lost and found.

Beyond Black Lives Matter is designed to help adoption organisations, social workers and families develop better communications around race. We look at the power of language to help us build cohesion and trust. What can science tell us about racism & trauma? We look at transracial adoption, placements, identity, birth story work and we encourage professionals to share their knowledge, discuss and find creative solutions.

Diversity and Difference is a powerful unifying and fun seminar, aimed at any team, seminar or conference group that want to expand their understanding about what difference is, means and how to be equipped to deal with todays ever changing cultural issues. We learn how to re-shape and navigate divisive words and attitudes and much more.

Wellbeing Wealth is as it says on the tin! We look at ways to develop a 'wellbeing toolkit' and how to explore and share wellbeing to our teams/people we serve? What is the science behind racism or conflict? This is either a stand alone seminar or combined with both other seminars.

All seminars come with pre-course reading, an interactive powerpoint presentation, slides for all attendees, notes and post-seminar reading.


